

2018 CJAA GOLDEN TREND RULES

1. Cattle "Check In" will be from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm on Friday, June 1st 2018. No cattle will be checked in after 12:00pm. In hardship cases such as vehicle breakdown exceptions will be considered. CJAA advisors must be notified as soon as possible in the event of a hardship case.
2. **HEALTH CERTIFICATE REQUIRED BEFORE UNLOADING.** All cattle must be previously health inspected by exhibitor's veterinarian within 15 days of the Golden Trend. All cattle will be inspected for general health when unloaded. Any animal found showing evidence of infections, contagious or communicable diseases will be rejected.
3. All entry, registration and eligibility requirements must be met at the time of inspection as described in the NJAA General Rules-Eligibility of Exhibitors and Entries.
4. All cattle must be stalled at the CSU facility and remain on the CSU facility until released at 3:00 pm on Saturday, June 2nd 2018.
5. Golden Trend is a "no fit blow and go" show. No adhesives or paint permitted.
6. Exhibitors in showmanship must use their own animal properly entered in the Golden Trend.
7. Photography Contest: Only one photo per contestant may be entered and displayed. Categories are Angus Cattle, Angus Landscape, Angus People and Around the Farm or Ranch. Bring your 10 X 8 photo to Golden Trend. Photos must be available to display by 3:00 pm on Friday, June 1st 2018.
8. All other contests including Career Development, Graphic Design, Writing, Beef Science Poster (Juniors only), Prepared Public Speaking and Extemporaneous Public Speaking will be conducted according to NJAA rules. 9. Any member interested in seeking a 2018-2019 CJAA office must complete the 2018 CJAA Officer Application. Application is due May 15th.
10. All entries and entry fees are due May 15th. There is no entry fee for individual contests, but please indicate on the entry form if you are interested in competing.
