

ANGUS CLASSIFICATION

(Classes may be divided into more divisions if number of entries warrants)

OWNED HEIFERS:

Class 1 – Junior Heifer Calves	Born after 1-1-2018
Class 2 – Senior Heifer Calves	Born 9-1-2017 to 12-31-2017
Class 3 – Intermediate Heifer Calves	Born 5-1-2017 to 8-31-2017
Class 4 – Junior Yearling Heifers	Born 1-1-2017 to 4-30-2017
Class 5 – Senior Yearling Heifers	Born 9-1-2016 to 12-31-2016

BRED & OWNED HEIFERS:

Class 6 – Junior Heifer Calves	Born after 1-1-2018
Class 7 – Senior Heifer Calves	Born 9-1-2017 to 12-31-2017
Class 8 – Intermediate Heifer Calves	Born 5-1-2017 to 8-31-2017
Class 9 – Junior Yearling Heifers	Born 1-1-2017 to 4-30-2017
Class 10 – Senior Yearling Heifers	Born 9-1-2016 to 12-31-2016

BRED & OWNED BULLS:

Class 11 – Junior Bull Calves	Born after 1-1-2018
Class 12 – Senior Bull Calves	Born 9-1-2017 to 12-31-2017
Class 13 – Intermediate Bull Calves	Born 5-1-2017 to 8-31-2017
Class 14 – Junior Yearling Bulls	Born 1-1-2017 to 4-30-2017

COW/ CALF :

Class 15 Cow/Calf Class – Cows three (3) years of age and younger, cows must be born after January 1, 2015. Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and be no more than 280 days of age on the day of the show.

Class 16 Cow/Calf Class – Cows four (4) years of age and older, cows must be born on December 31, 2014 or earlier. Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and be no more than 280 days of age on the day of the show.

Note: Any female that qualifies for the female classes in the Association's standard classifications are not eligible to show in the cow/calf classes. However, the calf at side of the female is eligible to show in its respective class.

STEERS:

Class 17 – Senior Steer Calves	Born 9-1-2017 to 12-31-2017
Class 18 – Intermediate Steer Calves	Born 5-1-2017 to 8-31-2017
Class 19 – Junior Yearling Steers	Born 1-1-2017 to 4-30-2017

COMMERCIAL ANGUS:

Class 20 – Non-placing Commercial Angus Steer or Heifer Class giving younger CJAA members the opportunity to participate Born After 1-1-2017
